Arrangements for attending services

- Please queue up at the church door keeping 2 metres apart from anyone outwith your household.
- You will be welcomed at the door and asked to use the hand sanitiser.
- Please wear a face covering a mask, vizor, scarf or similar. A disposable mask will be offered to you if you need one.
- You will then be asked for your name and phone number for Track and Trace (this will be kept for 3 weeks then destroyed).
- An Usher will then lead you to your seat.
- Please bring your poly pocket with the Blue Service Book,
 White Reserved Sacrament Book and reading sheet with you and take it home after the service.
- Please bring your own water bottle with you if you think you might need to drink during the service.
- The usher will indicate when to go for Communion. Please use the hand sanitiser on the way up to Communion and again on the way back to your seat.
- At the Altar rail please remain standing to receive the bread. (Only the Priest will receive the wine.)
- At the end of the service please leave when the Usher indicates.
- Please keep socially distanced at all times.
- You are allowed to smile!
